

Middle School Sports and Building/Shelter Questions/Answers

Middle School Sports

1. Are physicals required?

Yes, physicals are required for all sports. You must have a physical completed before the first practice. Turn Sports Physical into the Middle School you attend to Sports Coordinator or Main Office.

2. Does my child need to get a new physical for each sport?

No, the physical is valid for 365 days.

3. Where does my child report on the first day of practice?

Your child will report to the gym on the first day of practice to meet your coach.

4. When we register will I receive any more information?

Yes, you will receive a welcome email (please enter your email correctly when creating account) with coach's contacts, and information regarding practices and games.

5. Are scholarships available?

Yes, if your child receives free/or reduced lunch then the program is half priced. There is an available scholarship option on the online registration site.

6. Where can I find the game schedule?

You will receive the game schedule through email but also the schedule will be posted on our website www.albemarle.org/parks.

7. How will I be notified of cancellation? (weather)

You will receive an email regarding cancellations.

8. Can I receive a refund?

Yes, you can receive a refund. You will receive a check from Albemarle County in 2-3 weeks. (Please check your schedule before registering).

Shelters Reservations

1. If I reserve a shelter during summer swim season, do we have to pay the park entry fee?

Yes, in addition to the shelter reservation fee everyone that enters the park will have to pay the park entry fee.

2. If I want to pay for my guests, how can I do that?

3. You can set this up with the Cashier when you enter the Park on the day of your reservation. The Cashier will keep a count. Please settle payment with Cashier before they leave at 6pm. (cash or check only)

5. When I reserve a shelter, how long do I have the reservation for?

The rental block is from 8am-8pm but all our parks close at dark.

6. Is alcohol allowed with our shelter reservation?

No, alcohol is prohibited at all our parks.

7. Are bounce houses allowed?

Yes, but the company that provides the bounce house must have a generator to operate the bounce house.

8. Are water bounce houses allowed?

No, water bounce houses are not allowed.

9. Are we allowed to have music, i.e. Speakers, DJ?

No, amplification whether music, microphones or speakers.

10. Are we required to clean after our event?

The party is responsible for general clean up after use of the shelter. Dispose of your litter properly.

Community Centers

1. How much does it cost to reserve a community center?

The rental fee is \$50 an hour with a 2-hour minimum reservation. There is a 1-hour buffer between each reservation for staff to clean. (IE) if you are looking for a 2-hour party please look for a 3-hour time slot.

2. Are we required to clean after our event?

The party is responsible for general clean up after use of the community center. Dispose of your litter properly.

3. Is alcohol allowed in community center reservation?

No, consumption of alcoholic beverages in all community centers is prohibited.

4. Are there additional fees for skating parties?

A fee of \$2.00 is charged for skate rental. Our supervisor will keep track of the number of rentals which you can pay at the end of your party (cash or check only).

5. Can I get a refund?

Yes, you can receive a refund. You will receive a check in the mail from Albemarle County in 2-4 weeks.

6. Can we bring our own music?

Yes, you can bring your own music.
