1. Call to order & Agenda Review

- A. The meeting was called to order by Chair Dick Ruffin at 6:15 pm. The meeting agenda was reviewed.

- C. Allison Wrabel, Community Connector, Albemarle County, present.
- D. Bea LaPisto-Kirtley, Supervisor, Albemarle County Rivanna District, present.
- E. A quorum was confirmed to be present.

2. Meeting minutes approval from December meeting pending –Dick Ruffin, Chair

3. Presentation- Allison Wrabel summarized results of a survey of 48 members of Albemarle CACs that showed a high level of satisfaction. She also reviewed subjects addressed by PCAC in the last year or two and indicated that subjects on the agenda for 2025 include AC44, the county budget and economic development.

- A. Rules for Virtual meetings approved – including increased allowed virtual meetings from 25% to 50%, cannot be consecutive, and member must keep camera on for total meeting
- B. Future meeting dates discussed. Allison Wrabel will send out an amended list based upon the discussion
- C. Topics for future meetings were discussed.
 - i. Breakout rooms of two people discussed privately and then presented ideas to the group

- ii. Ideas included: update on school construction, zoning 101, police presentation, Rivanna River corridor update (including Old Mill Trail), safety issues including for pedestrians along Rt. 250 and Rt. 20, road signage issues, transportation update, including report on status of maintenance of Free Bridge, planning commission update

- 4. Bea LaPisto-Kirtley presented Albemarle County Supervisor update.
 - A. VDOT is installing park and ride on North side of Rt. 250 at Peter Jefferson Drive. There will also be a new sidewalk along Peter Jefferson near Rt. 250. Regional transit authority development.
 - B. Proposal for speed cameras in rural areas is going nowhere.
 - C. Microcat is going well and there is consideration of expansion.
 - D. There is a plan to establish a Regional Transportation Authority.
 - E. Online application for single family homes streamlined
