



SUMMER RECREATION CAMP 2026

(FULL-DAY)
(Ages 6-13)

The Albemarle County Parks and Recreation Department will be sponsoring the Summer Recreation Camp at four locations. This program is for children ages six to thirteen. The program consists of organized recreational activities, sports, games, contests, arts & crafts, and special events. This program is run in coordination with summer school.

- Child must turn six by November 30, 2026. (No Exceptions, this is a daycare license requirement)
- This program is open to all children in the age group.
- Maximum of 90 participants for each location.

***Cost of camp is a one-time fee (\$220), whether you attend one day, one week, or both weeks, includes field trips to Albemarle County Lakes for swimming.**
